

Goals

To contribute to the advanced, specialized and multidisciplinary training of Spanish-speaking security professionals in Latin America, Europe and the Maghreb, encouraging the creation of high-level networks with institutional projection.

To offer advanced studies on strategic and operational management, and offering good practices in international security issues which has a great geopolitical interest (risks and threats, organized crime, police intelligence, technological innovation in border management, road safety, environmental protection, weapons and explosives control, etc.)

To constitute an offer of great interest in the international scope (IBERPOL, FIEP, AMERIPOL, CEPOL, EUROPOL, etc.)

Blended Modality: It is carried out along the year course (from december to september) through an advanced academic programme which contains three modules remotely, using the CUGC virtual classroom (www.cugc.es) with three weeks of on-site activities in each module including:

- ⇒ On-site learnings.
- Mentoring sessions, teamworks and works presented on line.
- ⇒ National and international visits and practices.
- Academic researches.

The on-site activities will take place at Colegio Infanta María Teresa. C/ Príncipe de Vergara 248, de Madrid, which has a residence for students. However, it is planned to carry



out on-site activities of each module in other locations in America and Europe.
